The Wild, Wild West Buffalo Bill Museum and Grave

Background: When it comes to historical characters, few embody the spirit of the American West more than Buffalo Bill. Born William Frederick Cody in Iowa in 1846, he rose to international fame as a showman. 2017 marked the 100th anniversary of his death here in Colorado, but his larger-than-life reputation and legacy continue to live on.
