Scavenger Hunt Museum of Boulder

Encourage kids to explore one of the museum's exhibits by sending them on a scavenger hunt to uncover artifacts at the museum that might typically be overlooked. Tasked to find the smallest item to the strangest item, many discoveries are bound to happen. For this activity, kids will enjoy discovering objects in the museum they perhaps would have missed before.

Word Alert:

- **Scavenger Hunt**—a game in which you look and find items on a list.
- Artifact—an object that is human-made, usually from an earlier timer period.
- **Novelty**—quality of being original or new.

Questions to Ask:

Prior to going in:

• What do you expect to find in the museum?

After the visit:

- What surprised you the most about the museum?
- What was your favorite artifact in the museum?
- What will you remember most about the Museum of Boulder?
