Who was Edwin Carter? Edwin Carter Discovery Museum

Explore what makes a person great enough to have their actions continue for generations at the Edwin Carter Discovery Center.

Background:

Edwin Carter traveled to Colorado in search of gold but he gave up mining to become a naturalist. He collected everything including animals, insects and plants. In his cabin, he performed taxidermy on over 3,300 specimens, including those large, such as the bison, and small, the hummingbird. Word Alert:

- Taxidermy the art of preserving an animal's body by mounting or stuffing it.
- Naturalist a person who becomes an expert in natural history.
